Conference Theme: Beyond the Disaster: Healing Minds, Strengthening Communities, and Building Resilience

We are delighted to invite you to submit your abstracts for the 14th Annual Conference of Health Foundation Nepal (HFN), scheduled for **November 13-15, 2026, in Baltimore, USA.**

Every year, this conference provides a platform for researchers, healthcare professionals, and community advocates to share their innovative and impactful work in Nepal's community health. This year, we are focusing on disaster-related community health interventions, including strengthening health systems' resilience to meet the immediate and long-term mental health needs of affected communities.

We welcome all research in this theme from current or past disaster experiences in Nepal.

Mode: To make this conference accessible to a wider audience, we have made this conference virtual this year and will take place on November 13, 8-10 pm Eastern US time (i.e., Nov. 14, 6:45-8:45 am Nepal time).

Target Audience: Our annual conference is attended by academics working in global health, medical, nursing, and public health professionals, including students in those fields, philanthropists, and the local Nepali diaspora in the area. This is a good opportunity to share your work with this audience.

Submission Guidelines:

Please submit a structured abstract of no more than 250 words before the submission deadline. The abstract should include

- Title
- Authors' names with their degrees and affiliations
- Presenting author's name and email address
- Type of study
- Background, Methodology, Results, and Conclusion (250-word count limit applies to this section)

Types of study could be:

- Original research: Present your original research methodologies and results. This could be population health research or clinical studies.
- Community Programs: Share successful community health programs and their impact
- Case Studies: Present real-life cases, challenges faced, solutions implemented, and scalability.

Notification of Acceptance: Authors will be notified of abstract acceptance by October 31, 2026. All presenting authors should also register for the conference, which includes a nominal registration fee. Instructions for registration and preparing the presentation will be sent with the acceptance notification.

Important Note: We are soliciting **only oral presentations** for this conference. Please submit abstracts only if the designated presenting author is able to attend the conference virtually and present your study live.
